



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR I-MOVIE

### FROM CAMERA

- 1) Open iMovie
- 2) To download video from a camera, plug the camera in. An import window will appear.
- 3) Click on Events tab to the left and open your movie



### FROM WEBCAM

- 1) Open i-movie
- 2) Click Import Camera and click capture
- 3) Click capture again to start recording. Click stop to stop recording.

### NEW PROJECT

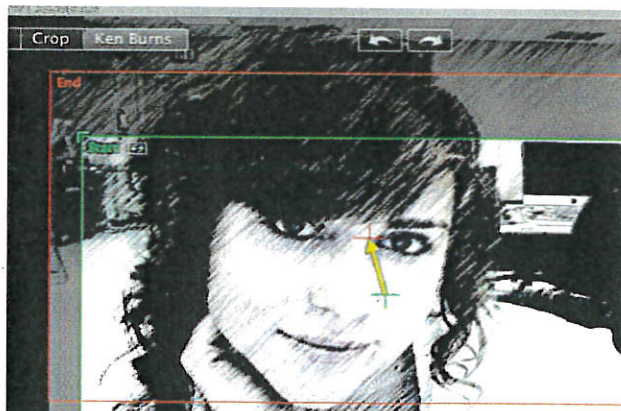
1. File  New Project
2. Name your project
3. Select "Widescreen (16:9)" for Aspect Ratio
4. No Theme
5. No Automatically add features
6. Import audio track into iMovie. Drag the audio track into iMovie where it says "Drag media here to create a new project" (upper left section of window).
7. Create a new event (a space for files you want to eventually use). Select "File>New Event". Enter name for event.
8. Import movies into this event. Select "File  Import  Movies". Select the movie

### EDIT CLIPS

- 1) Insert videos into the project. From the event box, select the time of the movie desired. To do this, click on this movie. Then drag the yellow highlight box to the left and extend the right end out until it reaches the time you want. For increased precision, drag the ruler on the lower right of the iMovie panel to the left. This essentially acts like a magnifying glass. Copy

## 2) Drag image to project window

- i. To edit duration of its appearance, click on photo and chose clip adjustments
- ii. To remove Ken Burns from all photographs select the first photograph in the project. Double click on the icon in the upper left of the image. This image was not shot with a 16:9 ratio. To make the image fill the screen, select "Crop". Adjust the crop window by dragging corners of this window. Click on the next image you want to change.
- iii. To edit the Ken Burn effect (zoom in) on the image instead of clip adjustments click Cropping, Ken Burns & Rotations
  - Green box is where image will start
  - Red box is where image will end



- iv. Select "Done" after you have made all the fit/ crop/ ken burns adjustments.

## ADD MUSIC



- 1) Click on the music tab in the media bar.
  - i. Browse for song in i-tunes then drag to gray space in the project window.
  - ii. Music will show up as green. To edit where the music starts or ends simply drag the ends.

- To edit length of small clip simply drag ends

#### ADD VOICE OVER



- 1) Click on microphone button on media tab and record

#### ANIMATED MAPS



- 1) Drag and the style globe you want and enter in the starting location and destination

#### TO SAVE

- Go to **SHARE** at top of the tool bar and click 'Export w/ Quicktime'
- You also have the option to post to Youtube by clicking Youtube
